RULES: General Terms and Conditions

The 20th Lyon International Chamber Music Competition (CIMCL) is dedicated to **Voice and piano Duo**. It is open to artists of all nationalities born after 23rd April 1991.

All types of voices are eligible to take part to the competition. The pianist must meet the same same age criteria as the singer.

The competition will award three major prizes (1st, 2nd and 3rd place), as well as a handful of other special prizes.

The competition is set to take place in Lyon, France, from Wednesday 23rd April to Saturday 26th April 2025.

APPLICATIONS

The closing date for applications is 15th January 2025 (11:59PM – Paris time) Candidates must submit by email the following documents:

Any bank fees incurred are to be covered by the candidates. Please specify **the name of the Duo** when you make the bank transfer to simplify the identification process.

ADMISSION

The organisers of the competition will pre-select candidates.

Candidates must send **uncut live video recordings** of three works, <u>before midnight on 15th January 2025 (11:59PM Paris time)</u>. Each work may be recorded separately. 6 to 10' of music are enough.

- A French melody
- A German lied
- A work sung in a different language

Videos must be sent as an Internet link: Youtube, Vimeo, Dropbox, etc. Artists must be filmed with a fixed camera. The videos should display the names of the artists, the works and composers, as well as the date and location of the recording.

Only complete application files will be accepted. Candidates will be informed of their admittance by e-mail by 10^{th} February 2025.

15 to 20 Duos will be selected to take part in the competition in Lyon.

The order in which the candidates will appear will be determined by drawing lots by the competition organisers a few weeks before the start of the event.

TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

Candidates must cover their own travel and accommodation expenses.

There is a limited amount of accommodation in homestays available. Please let us know if you are interested in such accommodation following the results of the preselection round.

Priority will be given to interested candidates who travel to Lyon from the furthest distances. Please let us know if you are interested in a homestay, once the pre-selection process has been completed.

REGISTRATION

Candidates must register and present their ID at the competition venue on **Tuesday 22nd April**, **2025 between 1:00pm and 6:00pm**.

REHEARSALS

Rehearsal rooms will be available for candidates from 1pm on Tuesday 22nd April and throughout the duration of the competition. The competition organisers will provide a schedule to ensure equal use of rehearsal rooms.

COMPETITION PROCEDURE

All rounds will be open to the public. The jury reserves the right to interrupt the contestants' performance or to select certain movements from the chosen pieces. The playing order of the selected pieces is left to the discretion of the candidates.

The musical rounds may be recorded (audio and video) for broadcast (live or on replay) via various platforms (Université Lumière Lyon 2, Violin Channel, Facebook live...).

PROGRAM

To allow the Duos to show the breadth of their work in different musical styles, all the pre-selected Duos will perform two recitals. At the end of this series, 3 Duos will be selected for a final recital on the last day.

Stage 1 - 23rd, 24th, 25th April - Main hall of Université Lumière Lyon 2

Each pre-selected Duo will need to perform two 30-minute recitals, including, in any order:

- 1. At least one work (whole cycle or extract) from among Henri Duparc, Maurice Ravel, Gabriel Fauré, Charles Koechlin, Claude Debussy ou Francis Poulenc
- 2. At least one work (whole cycle or extract) from among Franz Schubert, Johannes Brahms, Hugo Wolf ou Gustav Mahler
- 3. At least one work (whole cycle or extract) sung in a language other than French or German
- 4. At least one work or excerpt from a work by a French composer written after 1990
- 5. The new work, commissioned by the CIMCL and Royaumont Foundation (duration 12' to 15'). Score available from February 2025

Stage 2 - Saturday 26th April

At the end of the first three days and all 2 recitals, the jury will choose 3 to 5 duos to give a final 45-minute recital (maximum on stage) on Saturday 26th April.

The final recital must include:

- a entire cycle of lieder or melodies
- at least 2 melodies with string quartet from the list of French melodies below, proposed in collaboration with the Palazzetto Bru Zane - Centre de musique romantique française -Duration 15' maximum.

A string quartet will be made available to candidates by the competition. Rehearsals will be organised on the day.

Further details

Candidates must ensure that they do not exceed the maximum times indicated.

Candidates may decide to play extracts form cycles or cycles in their entirety.

For the final, a cycle must be played in its entirety.

The works given in the preselection round may be performed during the competition in Lyon. Candidates may not play the same piece more than once in different recitals.

Competition organisers will inform the candidates of the order of the recitals (Recital A, Recital B) during April 2025. Candidates are free to arrange the pieces within each recital.

Candidates will not perform more than once on the same day, with the exception of the finalists, who will be asked to perform one or two extracts at the prize-giving concert on the evening of Saturday 26^{th} April.

Many honorific and cash prizes will be awarded for specific interpretations, originiality, conceptions, particular attention to contemporary music etc. The list of these awards will be specified when you confirm your registration.

AWARDS CEREMONY AND CONCERT

The awards ceremony will take place on the evening of Saturday 26th April 2025. Award winners must be present to receive their prizes and will be asked to perform an excerpt from their competition program, as approved by the organisers of the concert. The concert may be recorded.

The winners will receive a fee of €150 for their performance at the winners' concert.

DELIBERATION

The jury will be composed of five or more members from the music world, selected by the competition committee. The president of the jury will be nominated by the competition committee. The jury will deliberate at the end of each round. The jury's decisions are final.

RECORDING AND BROADCASTING

Competition organisers reserve the right to record all or part of the competition using photographic or video technology, for advertising purposes, archives, television, Internet or radio broadcasting in accordance with the rights of French musicians (article L 212-3, Intellectual Property Code).

OBLIGATIONS

Registration for the competition implies that candidates agree with and accept all of the articles of the above rules.

The original French version of these rules takes precedence.

Disputes will be settled by the relevant authorities in Lyon.
